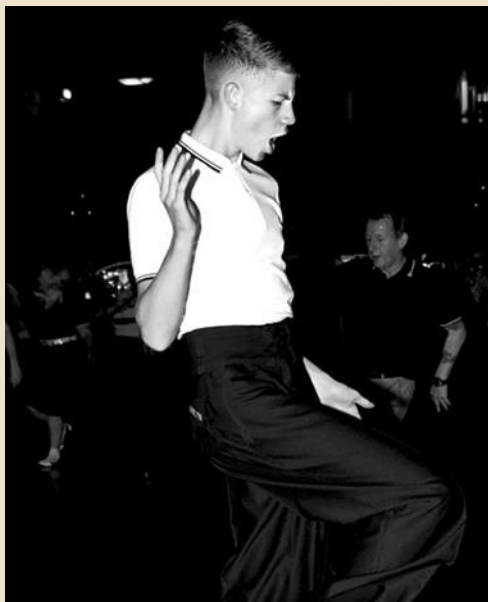
A series of dance poems that express the invisible energetic, connective tissue that joins us
